Elijah Hits the _____

The _____:

Immediately the fire of the LORD flashed down from heaven and burned up the young bull, the wood, the stones, and the dust. It even licked up all the water in the ditch! ³⁹And when the people saw it, they fell on their faces and cried out, “The LORD is God! The LORD is God!” (2 Kings 18:38-39 NLT)

The _____:

¹When Ahab got home, he told Jezebel what Elijah had done and that he had slaughtered the prophets of Baal. ²So Jezebel sent this message to Elijah: “May the gods also kill me if by this time tomorrow I have failed to take your life like those whom you killed.” (2 Kings 19:1-2 NLT)

The _____:

Elijah was afraid and fled for his life. (2 Kings 19:3 NLT)

He sat down under a solitary broom tree and prayed that he might die. “I have had enough, LORD,” he said. “Take my life, for I am no better than my ancestors.” (2 Kings 19:4 NLT)

The _____: [these are a one at a time deal, all the burn out subs at once]

_____ : *Then he lay down and slept under the broom tree. But as he was sleeping, an angel touched him and told him, "Get up and eat!"* ⁶*He looked around and saw some bread baked on hot stones and a jar of water! So he ate and drank and lay down again.* (1 Kings 19:5-6)

_____ with God: So he got up and ate and drank, and the food gave him enough strength to travel forty days and forty nights to Mount Sinai, the mountain of God. ⁹There he came to a cave, where he spent the night. (2 Kings 19:8 NLT)

_____ with God: *Elijah replied, "I have zealously served the LORD God Almighty. But the people of Israel have broken their covenant with you, torn down your altars, and killed every one of your prophets. I alone am left, and now they are trying to kill me, too."* (1 Kings 19:10 NLT)

Renewed _____ Plan: *Then the LORD told him, "Go back the way you came, and travel to the wilderness of Damascus. When you arrive there, anoint Hazael to be king of Aram. ¹⁶Then anoint Jehu son of Nimshi to be king of Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel-meholah to replace you as my prophet.* (1 Kings 19:15-16 NLT)

Renewed _____: *Anyone who escapes from Hazeal will be killed by Jehu, and those who escape Jehu will be killed by Elisha! ¹⁸Yet I will preserve seven thousand others in Israel who have never bowed to Baal or kissed him!"* (1 Kings 19:17-18 NLT)
