



CTV Spring House Construction Puebla, Mexico

JUNE 23-30, 2012



Join us for a spiritual adventure in the hills of central Mexico, as we work to turn the contaminated water on the left, into a clean and sanitary water system, as pictured on the right. Through spring box construction, and village health outreach, we partner with our friends from Living Water International (<http://www.water.cc>) to win an opening for the message of life in Christ among the villages.

FAQ's

Age Requirements? Parents are welcome to bring children who can handle the riggers of travel and physical work.

Skills needed? None required—just a willingness to work. Most of the work is simple physical labor. There are also opportunities to help with healthy self-care training with the villagers for individuals who cannot work.

How Much Will It Cost? \$1,150 - \$1,400. Actual cost depends on airfare cost, and whether or not individuals want a refundable fare. Refundable fares tend to be 30% higher but can be cancelled and transferred. Trip participants who cancel are responsible for their airfare. A deposit of \$250.00 is needed to hold your spot. The cost of inoculations and travel documents is **not** included.

Where is Puebla? Puebla is both a state and a city. It is situated in a broad, high valley about 60 miles southeast of Mexico City. We will be working in a village about 40 miles from Puebla.

Who Leads the Trip? Pastor Chip leads most of these trips, guiding the group through a daily devotional and assisting in the planning and oversight of the actual work.

Do Attendees Have To Go To CTV? No, anyone who is willing to be a team player and share the work is welcome, regardless of the church background or current faith commitments.

Is English Spoken There? Many people speak English in the city of Puebla, but in the village where we will construct the spring house only Spanish and Indian dialects are spoken. We will have an interpreter.

How Do We Get There? We fly to Mexico City and take an air-conditioned coach bus to Puebla.

Do I Need A Passport? Yes, passports are required.

Do I Need Shots? Sorry, you will need a couple of inoculations. The Centers for Disease Control recommends the following:

- ⇒ Hepatitis A or immune globulin
- ⇒ Typhoid vaccine
- ⇒ Tetanus-diphtheria
